Length of the study abroad/exchange period at Temple: one (1) year or one (1) semester

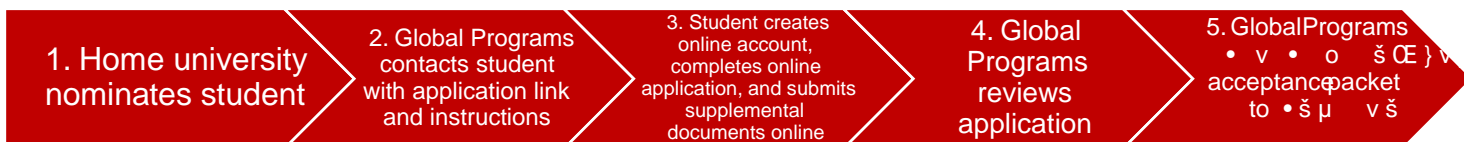
Study Abroad: Typically, up to 10 students from one institution at any given time
