APPLYING FOR A VISA

Stuck on the wording for your visa application? Follow these guidelines:

1. Detail the amount of time you will be in the United States.
2. Say that you will be taking courses at the University of Cincinnati, and describe those courses (ask an advisor which courses have been selected for your university).
3. Explain that you will also be experiencing American culture through activities and corporate visits.
